# Holy Spirit Community School Site Improvements:

You may be aware that we are currently working on a master plan for our school. This plan sets out the site as it is and more importantly has designs for what we believe we need. Gracie Smith has been an invaluable help in this process. Part of what she has been working on are several playground improvements.

As you know we have shifted the sandpit and rebuilt it as you walk in the

entrance to the school.

The Sensory Garden has begun and stage one has been completed as the

first of 6 stages.

- A 'Gaga Pit' is about to be constructed where the shipping containers were previously located.
- A new fence is being constructed in the prep playground area as plans are being incorporated to improve the space available to our preps to play in.

This fence is the beginning of this process.

The courts will be resurfaced (after the fete) with financial assistance from the P&F.

Currently under discussion:

An engineer is being contracted to prepare a report about the workmanship of the soft fall under the adventure playgrounds. Rectification is a

top priority of this area as it is not suitable after a heavy downfall of rain. The erection of permanent goals on the oval area.

Our students are at the forefront of any decision to improve our site. This takes time and money and all suggestions are welcome.
