



Holy Spirit Community School Uniform Policy

Rationale

We believe that the uniform of Holy Spirit Community School creates and promotes a sense of belonging, unity and identity to the individual and to the wider community.

Aims

- To promote equality amongst all students.
- To develop and instil a sense of pride in and identification of our school.
- To maintain and enhance the positive image of Holy Spirit in the community.

Implementation

Holy Spirit Community School positively encourages students to wear and take pride in their uniform at all times. It is expected that students wear full school uniform as stipulated in the Holy Spirit Uniform Policy.

It is the School's responsibility to notify parents of students who do not wear correct school uniform. If continual infringements occur the Principal will be notified.

Therefore it is the students, parents and School's responsibility to ensure and encourage the wearing of the correct uniform at all times by following the guidelines below:

Students are expected to:

- Wear the correct school uniform at all times
- Be responsible for their own uniform at school
- Pass uniform infringement notices onto parents.

At Holy Spirit Community School we expect parents to:

- Ensure that their children wear the correct school uniform at all times
- Notify class teacher in writing if their child is unable to wear the correct uniform
- Label all parts of their child's uniform with their name
- Purchase clothing from the Uniform Shop to ensure conformity
- Respond to any notification that their child is out of uniform
- Repair/replace torn, ripped, worn or items of uniform when necessary
- Provide Year 6 students with their selected Year 6 windcheater.

Stipulation regarding uniform at Holy Spirit

- Jewellery - stud earrings and sleepers worn in the ears, plus watches are the only acceptable jewellery
- Hair ribbons, ties, scrunchies and hair bands must be blue, white or maroon

- Only plain navy blue beanies and scarves
- Socks must come above the ankle
- No coloured nail polish or imitation tattoos or transfers
- Extreme haircuts, styles or colours are not permitted
- Below shoulder length hair is to be tied back for health and safety reasons
- Holy Spirit School hats are to be worn in Terms 1 and 4.

Long or short sleeved white polo shirt with logo
White skivvy
Long grey pants or tunic frock - optional
Grey tights and or white above ankle socks
School windcheater
Black school shoes

Plain white above ankle socks
School windcheater
Appropriate sport shoes
Sunsmart school hat

Sports navy skort (Optional for girls)

Plain white above ankle socks
