#### Message from the Principal

Dear parents and friends

I'd like to begin by acknowledging Jacinta Bibby our Pastoral Associate and Father Peter Robinson. Due to the efforts of these two people we have not missed a school mass since the departure of Father Jose. Ash Wednesday last week was no exception. Our students learned further about the three key aspects that the period of Lent is about, namely 1. Prayer 2. Fasting (going without) 3. Almsgiving (giving to charity) The application of the ashes to symbolize penitence was also explained to our students.







Information sessions for each level are currently being held. The main purpose of these sessions is to assist in relationship building between home and school about the teaching and learning that the students are exposed to. Feedback has been sought to ensure that the sessions are worthwhile and definitely not a repeat of last year's. Please try and get along to one. There will be handouts provided afterwards however given the amount of communication going home to parents (Sharks Football club, ECSI surveys, Changes to privacy laws in this newsletter) the information from the levels may not come home till later next week.

We are working hard behind the scenes to improve the way we communicate with the community. Our staff have drafted a set of operating norms about Dojo, the newsletter and the website. I am most grateful to the parents on the Engagement Action Team who will assist in seeking feedback around this. Part of this process will include a clearly articulated grievance procedure as well.

A couple of reminders for events coming up in the next week or so. Our P&F are running a Twilight Cinema this Friday. We will proceed rain, hail or shine. If rain does hit the event will run in the community centre. Next Tuesday night we have a Reconciliation workshop and the week will round out with a Prep family dinner. All prep families are invited to attend.

First Reconcililation workshops will be held on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> March at both 5-6 pm and 7-8 pm in the Community Cen-

tre. All first reconciliation children and parents are required to attend one of these workshops. There will also be a Prep Dinner in the Community Centre on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> March at 7.30 pm. This is a wonderful opportunity for Prep parents to meet socially and in an informal atmosphere, especially if you are new to the school it is a great chance to meet and make friends with other parents.

You may have noticed in the Church that the red runner is no longer being used. This is due to a number of recent tripping incidents. It is appreciated that the runner adds colour and formality but we don't want to cause any unnecessary injury. If you have an alternative idea, please let us know.

Archbishop Peter Comensoli has sent a guidance letter to all parishes on the Coronavirus. The distribution of Holy Communion under both species is to cease. The chalice is not to be shared at any Mass and is for the celebrants use only.

Ministers of Communion must sanitise their hands before and after distributing Communion. Hand gel is available on the Sanctuary and bins will be placed for disposal of used tissues.

There is no need to take special measures on suspending the Sign of Peace however, those with coughs and sneezes, the vulnerable or those who feel uncomfortable about shaking hands may wish to exchange the Peace of Christ with a smile or bow and should be encouraged to do so. We can help prevent the spread of the virus with the practice of good hand and sneeze/cough hygiene.

The March edition of The Spirit Magazine has been distributed to the eldest child of each class. Please take the time to read it. It is full of wonderful and interesting news to both the Parish and School.

#### Changes to the Privacy Legislation –Child Information Sharing Scheme

In light of the findings arising from the Royal Commission into Family Violence, on 1 September 2020 changes to the current privacy legislation will take effect with the introduction of the Child Information Sharing Scheme ("CISS").

At the moment, Child Safe Standards and privacy, reportable conduct and mandatory reporting legislation whilst all having similar objectives, act independently from one another. The introduction of CISS will allow for a more centralised approach to information sharing and reporting with respect to the wellbeing and safety of children.

The purpose of these changes is to promote the wellbeing and safety of children by sharing information in order to better inform an action such as providing a service, undertaking an investigation or managing a risk.

#### What's new from September 2020?

From September 2020 organisations such as schools, kindergartens and Out of School Hours Care will become authorised Information Sharing Entities ("ISE"). This will enable them to share information with existing ISE's such as Child Protection, Maternal and Child Health Services and DHS etc, without being in breach of any privacy legislation.
