Dear parents, friends and Father Arsenio

What a triumphant return last week. Our P-yr2 students and staff returned to school and the smiles of joy were evident for all to see. I am grateful to the leaders at our school who were assisted by Katherine and Caeleigh to ensure that all was ready for our students. The early finish was warranted as I had many reports of students falling asleep very early.

We have taken a multi-pronged approach to our return to school this has included:

A deliberate classroom focus from teachers on Wellbeing. This is generally how each day begins at the moment and then we roll into literacy and numeracy sessions. I am satisfied that over the remainder of the year the staff will cover all academic requirements that need to be covered.

Angela Davis our school councilor has been employed for an additional day a week till the end of the year. This will allow her to not only reconnect with her current caseload, but to also deal with any issues that may arise given the recent changes.

Staff have been attending professional development relevant to the current situation. Given the changes we are implementing it is important that we have appropriately trained staff to deal with new requirements.

We are undertaking additional cleaning each day from I Iam-2pm. This will continue till the end of the term and I will then reassess the situation to work out the best way to proceed with this.

The staggered finish time is working extremely well. Please note that aside from Monday it is a 3:15pm (green / yellow) and 3:30pm (red / blue) dismissal.

The students from years 3-6 are scheduled to return next week. To assist the staggered finishing times, I am requesting that families who have older children (only in grades 3-6) park over the road in the IGA carpark or agree to meet in one of the side streets.

The staggered finish has worked so far. I am keen to see if we can keep green and yellow being dismissed at 3:15 (3pm Mondays) and red and blue at 3:30pm (3:15 Mondays). It will be a case of waiting to see how we go next Tuesday given the need to get 280 families off the site rather than 100. Thanks so much for your assistance to date.

Just a reminder that this Friday is a student free day. All staff are preparing for students to return to school next week and I appreciate the assistance of the board in approving this.

PARISH NEWS

A warm welcome back to our school students in Prep, Years I and 2. Next week we welcome back Grades 3-6. The Parish House is still not fully open due to the pandemic. With easing of some restrictions, Fr Arsenio is now able to celebrate Mass on a very limited basis. The Archdiocese and the Victorian Government have set very strict guidelines governing the service. There will only be 15 places for weekday masses (Wednesday and Friday at 10am) and 20 places for weekend masses (Saturday 6pm and Sunday 9am). Bookings must be registered with the Parish Office. Regular masses will not be resuming at this stage. The Church, Chapel and Parish office will remain closed until further notice (Parish toilet facilities are not available on parish property).

Also in this time of crisis there are more calls to St Vincent de Paul Society to provide assistance to those adversely affected. If you are in a position to donate any non-perishable goods, there is a basket on the doorstep of the Parish House where you can leave any donations.

Gar parking

In order to ensure that the car park remains as safe as possible during school drop off and pick up, we ask that you follow our car parking procedure as set out in the Parent Handbook (available on the website).

In particular, when parking on the basketball court, please ensure that

both sides of the court are being utilised. We also ask that when parking along the side adjacent to the Level 1/2 building, when reversing in you leave enough space to ensure that the pathway is clear (see picture).



With all the students due back to school next week we would like to remind everyone of the procedures for drop off and pick up, so that we can meet the guidelines that are in place for schools.

The students are not to get out of the car until they have reached the drop off point at the midway point between the two basketball courts.

When completing the drive through, stop only at the drop off point to let your child out and then continue on, to keep the traffic flowing.

NB: There is only one crossing for everyone – at the top of the basketball court near the flagpole. Only Prep children may be walked down to the classroom, please drop them at their classroom door.

If you need to park in the carpark, make sure the students cross at the 'manned crossing' if needed.

While you are waiting for your child, we request that you keep the mandated distance of 1.5 m between adults and please don't congregate in the school grounds. As soon as you have collected your child/ren please head out of the school grounds.

If you require a late pass or special circumstances/early leave pass they will be available from the office area. If you are required to collect your child early please contact the office and they will be waiting in the office foyer for you. Do not go through the black gates to the classroom or enter a classroom to collect your child.
