The Canticle of the Sun

Praised be You my Lord with all Your creatures, especially Sir Brother Sun, Who is the day through whom You give us light. And he is beautiful and radiant with great splendour, Of You Most High, he bears the likeness. Praised be You, my Lord, through Sister Moon and the stars, In the heavens you have made them bright, precious and fair. This verse is from a very famous prayer written in the 11th century by St Francis of Assisi. It was first written in Italian as a song and then translated into many languages.

St Francis of Assisi was a Franciscan friar who had a very deep connection to nature and the earth. His feast day is 4 Oct. His canticle is a song of praise and you can see from the language how close he felt to nature and creation by the way he refers to the elements as his brothers and sisters: Brother Sun, Sister Moon.
