Dear Families

The School Board met on 27 October and it was great to have Fr Arsenio with us. We had an opportunity to reflect on the transition back to onsite learning and the summary of results from the parent survey regarding Term 3 experiences. This feedback will be critical in shaping the remainder of Term 4 and Holy Spirit is very focussed on ensuring appropriate support is in place for the wellbeing of the children and for tracking their progress.

We had an excellent discussion about the need to focus on transition at all levels, particularly encouraging interyear level interactions to build social connections prior to the end of year, particularly for the junior school – for example Prep transitioning to Grade 1/2.

The School Board was delighted to welcome Andy McKellar (5/6 AG) and Dean McKellar to the meeting to provide an overview of their initiative *Teacher Presence*. This is an innovative platform that is designed to encourage those families who may choose to give a gift of thanks to a teacher at the end of the year, to instead consider making a donation through *Teacher Presence* which supports nominated charities. Andy was also recently featured on 3AW Breakfast – well done Andy!
