Dear Parents/Carers

Concessional School Fees Application 2026

Under our concessional fee policy, the following families are encouraged to apply for concessional fees in 2026:

- Any family of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander heritage
- Any family holding a Health Care Card **and** eligible for CSEF (cards held in students names are *not* eligible. Cards must be in Parent/Guardian's name)
- Any family holding a DVA Gold Card
- Any family identified as refugees and holding an ImmiCard

The school fee* for eligible students is:

- 1 child - \$15.58 per child per week, direct debit (\$810 per annum or \$202.50 per term)
- 2 children - \$23.85 for the family per week, direct debit (\$1,240 per annum, or \$310 per term)
- 3 + children - \$31.15 for the family per week, direct debit (\$1,620 per annum, or \$405 per term)

**Camps and swimming levies are in addition to this charge for each child.*

Applications may be made by submitting a MACS School Fees Concession Program form along with the provision of relevant supporting documentation and a direct debit form for either weekly, fortnightly or monthly payments. Application forms are available in the office and are attached to this email.

Successful applicants will be advised in writing with the concessions to be applied during the 2026 school year once CSEF payments are approved by relevant government body.

Please note - If you have applied for the Camp, Sports and Excursion Fund in previous years, you are not required to complete this form again. You will, however, need to complete and submit the MACS School Fees Concession Program form and the direct debit form.
